Air Canada Centre played host to the beautiful and sensational voice of Celine Dion for the second time this year. Dion was originally scheduled to perform at the A.C.C. back in April of 1999. However, due to her husband's poor health problems, her tour was temporarily postponed until September of 1999.

Although the concert was originally announced to be a total scratch, no one returned the tickets anticipating a new date would be rescheduled, which was the case.

Dion's rescheduled concert date spared no expenses. She had it all; the lights, the cameras, the action plus an eye-catching, big heart-shaped stage located at centre ice not to mention, Cory Hart as her opening band. He alone was worth the price of admission.

Cory Hart did an awesome job warming the crowd up for Celine. The fans really enjoyed watching Cory Hart in concert. In fact it seems that the whole time Cory Hart was performing, it felt like the crowd stood on their feet the whole time he was on stage. She sang her heart out for more then 2 and a half hours, performing more than 31 of her greatest hits.

Most importantly, from her husband, sitting way above the stage in a private v.i.p. box which the spotlight focused on, when Celine dedicated a special song to her husband, manager and record icon, Rene.

superstar friends whom were invited to appear on stage, with Celine via the A.C.C. jumbotron.
